Your travel options during the construction work




From Monday 5 June 2023, the T2 tramway will no longer be running due to the construction work for the future Blagnac interchange hub, which will connect the T1 tramway line with the future airport line and C metro line.

The tramway will not be stopping at the Nadot, Daurat and Aéroport stations during the construction work.

Your BUS and TRAM network will adapt to provide you with the best possible transport options during the construction period:

- > The frequency of your T1 trams has been doubled as far as Odyssud-Ritouret with the creation of a new interim terminus to better serve Blagnac.
- > the airport shuttle frequency has been boosted with a bus every 15 minutes (as opposed to 20 minutes previously).
- > the route of bus line 30 has been changed to include the Odyssud-Ritouret
 T1 tram station on the outward and return journeys
 (about a 7-minute trip to and from the airport),
- > a new bus line, 31 has been created to link the airport to the T1 tram stations, Pasteur-Mairie de Blagnac and Guyenne-Berry (estimated trip time between 9 and 15 minutes) from 5.30 am to midnight.



Employees, walking and cycling are good options too!


The Nadot stop can be reached in 10 minutes on foot from the T1 Servanty Airbus station and in 5 minutes on foot from the Dewoitine stop on BUS line 31.

Cycling can shorten your travel time. Find your cycling itinerary using the calculator on tisseo.fr or the Tisséo or Géovélo apps.

Toulouse city centre and Matabiau station (BUS)

You no longer need to buy a ticket!

Just pay with your bank card or smartphone with a contactless payment app in lieu of a ticket in the airport shuttle.

Multi-passengers: with family, friends, colleagues... you can use a single bank card or your smartphone to take the airport shuttle, up to 5 passengers (cardholder + 4 passengers).

A new Airport Line in 2026

The Airport Line project, to be completed in 2026,

will use the T2 tramway infrastructure to link the airport to the T1 line and then, from 2028, to the future C metro line (Blagnac station).

Construction work on the Blagnac interchange hub located at the

Jean-Maga roundabout between the Ancely and Servanty Airbus stations will be interrupting the T2 tram line to the airport.





In Blagnac, a direct link between the airport and Toulouse




In 2028, the C metro line will be connected to all modes of transport (train, bus, metro, tramway) to offer faster and more accessible trips to all parts of the Greater Toulouse area. This 27 km line will directly link the West, North, East and South-East of Toulouse, with 21 stations, 17 of which will be underground and 4 overhead.

The future Blagnac station will be located on a tree-lined esplanade, linking the metro, tramway, cycle routes and airport. It will also provide a direct link with the T1 tramway line and the Airport Line to connect Toulouse Matabiau station and Toulouse Blagnac airport.
